Minutes of the ITS Trail Committee February 5th, 2008

The meeting was opened at 7:14 PM.

We discussed the membership period for the ITS Committee. Up until now, we have been giving one year memberships, and having them come due after one year of membership. However, this is creating a complex record keeping situation. Octoberfest Ride: Russ Masinelli is talking with Trailnet about organizing the ride for the Octoberfest at St. Michael's. Unfortunately, as of the time of the meeting, he had yet to hear back from Trailnet regarding the ride, including insurance issues.
